To Whom It May Concern:

I hereby demand a copy of any documents, electronic or otherwise, that match any of the following criteria:

1. Any and all e-mail sent or received by TSA spokeswoman Sari Koshetz on March 6 – 8th, 2012
2. Any and all e-mail, messages, voicemail, or other documents sent by any TSA employee that caution any member of any media organization or Internet journalist (including bloggers) not to publish information regarding the “How Anyone Can Get Anything Past TSA Nude Body Scanners” YouTube video that was released March 6th, 2012
3. Any video taken at or near the security checkpoint for FLL airport “E” gates on Saturday, March 3rd, 2012, between 3:55 AM and 4:25 AM.
4. Any video taken at or near the security checkpoint for CLE airport USAirways gates on Sunday, March 4th, 2012, between 2:35 PM and 3:05 PM. For clarity, this is the first checkpoint one would find if approaching the terminal by car.

If a document contains information that cannot be released, please provide a redacted version that clearly indicates the reason for redaction.

This request is made under the Freedom of Information Act, not the Privacy Act; please do not send any Privacy Act waiver forms. I authorize up to \$250 in legitimate costs associated with processing this request without the need to contact me, however also request that you waive all costs. I seek a timely response and will litigate immediately following your deadline should no timely response be received.
